



AUSTRALASIAN HOSPITALITY GAMING (AHG) EXPO – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Australasian Hospitality Gaming Expo (AHG) Expo is a trade exhibition for authorised representatives of Hospitality Industry Organisations, including registered clubs, hotels, casinos, hospitality venues, relevant government and regulatory bodies, industry associations, and organisations that support the hospitality industry. Event Management reserves the right to determine eligibility for attendance.

Commercial suppliers, service providers and trade representatives may only attend if they are exhibitors, sponsors, approved partners, invited guests of Event Management, or are otherwise authorised to attend. Exhibitors are not authorised to 'invite' commercial suppliers to attend.

Conditions of Entry

By attending the AHG Expo, all Visitors and Exhibitors agree to comply with the following Conditions of Entry:

- Entry is permitted by authorised Entry Badge only.
- Entry Badges are issued to an individual and are not transferable.
- Entry Badges must be worn and clearly visible at all times while attending the event.
- Event Management reserves the right to cancel, deactivate or invalidate any Entry Badge at any time.
- Proof of identity may be required upon entry or during the event.
- Proof of affiliation with an eligible Hospitality Industry Organisation may be required.
- Any Entry Badge not matching the identity of the wearer may be confiscated.
- Any person attempting to enter the event using another person's Entry Badge will be refused entry or removed from the event.
- No person under 18 years of age is permitted to enter the exhibition.
- Notwithstanding the above, babies in suitable infant carriers may be permitted to enter the exhibition only with the prior written approval of the Event Manager.
- Photography, video recording or audio recording by Visitors is only permitted with the prior approval of both the Exhibitor concerned and Event Management.
- By attending the event, Visitors and Exhibitors acknowledge that photography, filming and recording may occur. Event Management may use images, video and audio captured during the event for promotional, marketing and reporting purposes unless otherwise advised by the individual or where prohibited by law.

- Event Management may approve or reject any Visitor or Exhibitor registration at its sole discretion.
- Event Management reserves the right to refuse admission to any person.
- Event Management may remove any person whose behaviour is considered disruptive, unsafe, offensive, threatening, inappropriate, or inconsistent with the professional nature of the event.
- Visitors and Exhibitors must comply with all reasonable directions issued by Event Management, venue management, security personnel and emergency services.
- Event Management reserves the right to inspect bags, packages and other possessions brought into the event.
- Any person who is not an approved Exhibitor and is observed conducting sales, marketing, solicitation or promotional activities during the exhibition will be removed from the event.
- Exhibitors may only conduct sales and promotional activities within the boundaries of their allocated exhibition stand.
- Visitors must not interfere with, disrupt or obstruct Exhibitors while they are conducting business.
- Exhibitor registrations are limited to employees or authorised representatives of the contracted Exhibitor unless otherwise approved by Event Management.
- Exhibitors must not sublet, share, assign or otherwise permit third parties to occupy or operate from their exhibition stand without the prior written approval of Event Management.
- Event Management reserves the right to approve or refuse any stand-sharing request at its sole discretion.
- Visitors and Exhibitors who breach these Conditions of Entry may have their Entry Badge cancelled and may be removed from the event without refund or compensation.

Liability

Visitors and Exhibitors attend the event at their own risk. To the maximum extent permitted by law, Event Management accepts no responsibility for any loss, damage, theft, injury, delay, expense or inconvenience suffered by any person while attending the event, except where liability cannot be excluded under applicable law.

Privacy

Personal information collected during registration will be managed in accordance with Clubs Queensland's Privacy Policy and applicable Australian privacy legislation.

Governing Law

These Conditions of Entry are governed by the laws of Queensland, Australia.
